- Use PhotoShop to manipulate the images you have taken.
- Help you learn how to use layers properly.

DETAILS

When you have captured your photograph along with the details that make up those photos, you need to create two complete "Scenes". You will do this by creating a blank image, then cropping and copying the pieces onto your blank image.

Step 1: Download your images into a "details" folder. Create a contact sheet and save is as a JPG to show all of your work.

Step 2: Creating the Scenes

- Create a blank document, size 8 in by 10 in, 150 resolution (or 10 x 8).
- Open the main image, the photo that shows the entire scene. Crop this photo to 6 in wide by 4 in tall (or 4 x 6). Copy the image and past it into the center of your blank document. Rename this layer "main." You should have two layers now. You should also save now – call it **details 1** or **details 2**
- Now you need to place the smaller "detail" images on the new document. Since they are smaller, crop them at 1.5 in wide and 2 in tall (or 2 x 1.5). Paste them into the details document and rename the layers something appropriate like "light," "handle," etc. Arrange these layers in their proper spots around the main image.
- You can create an outline or shadow for these layers by clicking on the correct layer in the Layers Palette, then use the Layers menu to go to Layer Styles>Stroke or Layer Styles>Drop Shadow.
- The next step is to outline the places on the main image that define where the "details" are. Start by drawing a rectangle with the Marquee tool. Go to the Select menu and drag down to Modify>Border. Use 2-3 pixels, and the border will expand. Go to the Edit menu and select Fill... choose either black, white, or another color that will stand out against your background.
- The final step is to draw a line from the details to your newly created boxes on the main image. Do this with the Line tool underneath the Rectangle tool. You will need to create a new layer: Layers menu> New> Layer.

Examples – the left images uses stroke around the details while the right uses a drop shadow.
