- Use a variety of Photoshop tools to discretely make subtle changes to a photograph.

DETAILS

For this assignment we are taking a page from People magazine. You will take a photograph of a 'scene', keep the original untouched, and then make a copy of it and change at least 10 things in the photo. Your goal is to be discrete so the viewer has to search to find the items you changed.

To begin this assignment you must figure out your 'scene' and take a photograph of it (try at least 10 photographs). The size of the photo should be 5x7 or 7x5. Save the photo as "original" in a folder titled Double Take. Next go to File>Save As and name the same photo "edited" in the same folder. This is the copy you will make 10 discrete changes to.

Requirements- One 8x10 document with the following:

1. One 5x7 or 7x5 original copy of the scene (at the left or top of page)
2. One 5x7 or 7x5 edited copy of the scene (at the right or bottom of page)
3. A title such as "Double Take" or "Spot the Difference" or you can come up with your own
4. A list of all the changes made upside down at the bottom of the page
