- Students will practice using Liquify in Photoshop.

### DETAILS

**Backgrounds:** Create TWO (4 x 4 inch) backgrounds. Save your "start" point as bg1start then save the file at bg1end so you have 2 files for each background. When you are finished you will have for files for backgrounds. Save them to the Liquify folder.

**Faces:** Find a picture of a person you would like to modify. Save person as f1start then save the file as f1end after you have finished liquifying the person. You will have 2 pictures for each - a before and an after. Repeat this for 3 more people. Save them to the Liquify folder.

When completed you will have 6 before files (2 backgrounds and 4 faces) and 6 after files (2 backgrounds and 4 faces). Create a contact sheet 4 COLUMN's x 3 Row's.
