## Famous Photographer Presentation Expectations

### Summary

To study the influences of famous photographers

### Final Product

give a 8-10 minute presentation describing the life and photographic history of the photographer you chose to study.

Your **8-10** minute presentation must use PowerPoint, and must be your original work (plagiarism will not be tolerated).

A suggested outline for your presentation:

- Begin with an opening slide that includes a title and photo.
- Tell us about them – where they grew up, any early influences, how they became interested in photography, anyone they studied with to learn.
- Show us a timeline of their significant events, especially those dealing with photography.
- During your presentation tell us why you chose this particular photographer, what you like or dislike about their work, and why you feel they are important to study.
- Tell the audience about their work. Why is it special, noteworthy, different? Did they specialize in a particular type of photography? Why are they famous or what are they famous for. Show distinguishing characteristics of their style.
- Your presentation should include MANY photos of theirs.
- Show us the photos that you took in the style of this photographer – compare them with their photos and tell us what you attempted to do.
- **DO NOT READ TO US!** And while you may list awards and jobs, there is no need to read a long list to us.

Presentations will start on April 23. The class will conduct a random draw on April 16 for the order of presentations – you could go on any day.

The day of your presentation, you will be required to turn in a digital copy of your presentation (turn in box).
