Summary

Your assignment is to take 50-plus photos of various different subjects (not 50 of the same subject). We are looking for **natural shots** that bring out the best in these subjects. Experiment to see how you can catch the moment, and show personality.

Your subjects are to be animals or young children. You could also shoot photos of both to see how it goes.

Some hints before starting:

Get down to their level. Perspective will be important here.

As usual, get in close for some shots – but experiment with wider shots as well.
