To help prepare your first semester portfolio.

Final Product

You will turn in 8 x 10 photos of your best 6 photos.

Due Date

November 10

In order to prepare your first semester portfolio, you will be making some tough choices about your best photographs.

This assignment is to help you gather your best work for the portfolios you will be building in January.

You will need to determine your best **SIX** photographs out of the hundreds you have chosen. This may take some hard decision-making, but it is necessary in order to compile your best work.

You should look at ALL of your photos from every assignment. Do not discard any photo without taking another look at it. You may want to make a folder of all your favorites (copy them, don't move them) and then start narrowing them down. You will also want to show a wide range of skills in your photos and will not want to take all photos from one assignment. The purpose of a portfolio is to show your talents, not just your favorite photos. Look for the best technical photos with a wide variety of skills.

You will print 8 x 10's to turn in, and you will be creating a digital folder with these photos in them. Call this folder Portfolio Q1.

We will also start to archive your photos by burning CD's at this point (assuming you have paid your lab fee of course).
